Then use the new "Instant Link Bank Account" function for online or downloaded purchases. Be sure to sign-up for weekly emails that contain information about bonus rebates and flash deals. For example, Lowe's is currently promoting a 50% increase in their rebate, which means 50% more money that goes back to the school.
