MARRIAGE MENTORING PROGRAM

Every year around a dozen couples are married at St. Peter's. While the weddings are fun and beautiful in our Sanctuary, the marriage itself is what is more important. For the past nine years, dedicated couples from our congregation have provided premarital preparation as part of the marriage mentoring program. These trained couples work one-on-one with premarital couples for six months to a year leading to the wedding. They share their stories, guide them through exercises, and encourage them to discuss and explore many areas important to preparing for marriage. To date, they have provided mentoring for 60 couples, and 5 additional couples are currently in the program. The newly married couples always report great blessings from their time with their mentors. A training class will be scheduled soon for new marriage mentors. 

We welcome children in worship, but if you need to use the nursery, it's on the lower level, down the stairs and to the immediate right.






PHOTO DIRECTORIES
