The next disaster recovery mission trip is scheduled for the two weeks of March 22-April 3. We will return to Panama City, FL. Volunteers can sign up for week one, week two, or both weeks. Fuller Center Disaster ReBuilders, the group we coordinate with, currently has seven houses on their list in Panama City to be rebuilt after being damaged by Hurricane Michael. FCDR also has a camp set up and operating in Houston, TX (Hurricane Harvey) and New Bern, NC (Hurricane Florence). They operate on donations, grants, and FEMA dollars to buy materials and on volunteers to accomplish their mission, so prayerfully consider joining the team.

ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday, February 26 which marks the beginning of the 40-day penitential season of Lent with the imposition of ashes and the celebration of the Lord's Supper as we prepare for the festival of Easter. This is a solemn event marked with the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return" as ashes are placed on the forehead or hand to remind us of our sinful condition and the need for a Savior to take away the sins of the world.
