Dear Members of St. Peter's,

In a time when everything seems so dire, we are excited to have some good news to share with you that only further proves how God has St. Peter's firmly in His hands. He is continuing to care for His people even during times of uncertainty.

Several months ago, we were contacted by Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, seeking our support. They explained that they had multiple students in need of a local placement for their vicarage year with only one congregation willing to take a vicar. To assist with this dire need, we were asked to consider taking a vicar for the 2020/21 academic year. The need was so great that the Seminary also offered to significantly reduce the cost usually charged to participate in this program if we were willing to accept an assignment.

Because we have not had a vicar at St. Peter's in a number of years, this request was very carefully and prayerfully considered. After extensive discussions with our ministry staff and our Director of Finance, it became clear that God was leading us in this direction. The Board of Directors concurred with our findings and, therefore, approved moving forward with the application for a vicar. Recently, we received word from the Seminary that a placement is most likely to happen during the call service on Wednesday, April 29.

We are thrilled at God's provision for our ministry and are eagerly looking forward to the opportunities He continues to present our congregation. I hope you will all join me in a extending a warm St. Peter's welcome to our new vicar whenever he is able to begin his assignment with us.
