# **Paycheck Protection Program**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

I hope this message finds you all in good health and spirits. I wanted to share some information with the congregation in regards to a decision that the Board of Directors made several weeks ago. As you all know, the pandemic caused the cancellation of all inperson worship. Due to these circumstances, the Board became concerned about the congregation's ability to financially support the ministry and all of its workers. We were unsure of how the Shelter-in-Place order would impact giving, especially when members might be out of work. Therefore, the Board began exploring options.

At that time, the LCMS was encouraging congregations to take advantage of a government option called the Paycheck Protection Program. This program enables the congregation to secure funds to pay their employees. Many area congregations were also considering this program. The Board felt it would be in the best interest of the congregation to explore this option. We learned that we would be eligible for a loan that would enable us to meet payroll for up to two months. We also learned that if at least 75% of the loan was used to meet payroll, we would not be required to repay the debt. The Board approved the application for loan.

Now, those of you familiar with our constitution and bi-laws, you know that the Board cannot secure a loan without approval from the congregation. Many of you are also aware that we were unable to hold a voters meeting due to pandemic guidelines. However, the Board felt that given the extreme circumstances, and because the loan is forgiven when used appropriately; we could and should make this decision. The Board felt that in the interest of protecting our ministry workers, as well as the overall finances of the congregation, we needed to take this step. We also felt that the program worked more as a grant than as a loan.

Despite these challenges, the Lord has continued to bless our ministry. Thanks be to God!
