Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) – I am excited to report that \$37,405 dollars were donated and directed to our school for scholarships to help families be able to afford a quality Christian education. These donations exceeded our goal of \$36,000. Due to the wonderful support of the SGO here at St. Peter's, we will be increasing the maximum scholarship amount this coming school year from \$1,000 to \$1,500 per student. This increase will help offset the ever-increasing cost of education for many grateful families.
