Faithfully Forward Campaign – Great news, with the February mortgage payment, we have now reduced our outstanding mortgage to below two million! (\$1.995 million) However, we still have plenty of work to do. As of 12/31/2020, which completes the second year of the four-year campaign, members and supporters have given \$1.563 million dollars and our forecast estimates that we will raise \$2.6 million by the end of the campaign. If the current giving trend continues, we will still need to raise \$900,000 - \$1,000,000 to pay off the building loan. Therefore, we really need everyone to complete his or her pledge if possible and it is not too late for someone to start supporting this
