#### Worship Times

- 1. 6:30 am Traditional worship in the Sanctuary with communion. This is traditionally a quieter service. So, if you would prefer to avoid a large crowd, we encourage you to consider this service time.
- 2. 8:00 am Traditional worship in the Sanctuary with communion. **Now Full**
- 3. 10:30 am Traditional worship in the Sanctuary with communion. Now Full
- 4. Stepping Stones style worship in the Church Gym with breakfast and communion. This worship service will contain the familiar liturgy and hymns but will be presented in the same style as our Monday evening Stepping Stones service. A free breakfast (scrambled eggs, sausage, biscuits, gravy, pastries, fruit and coffee) will be served from 8:45-9:10 for all those who will attend this service. Worship will begin shortly thereafter. You will worship at a table with your family/group. This is sure to be a meaningful, uplifting time of worship and fellowship.
