## Elevator Can Be Used

While, there is still maintenance pending on the elevator, it *can* be used. If the doors don't open for you right away, just continue to push the button of the Floor Level you wish to exit at. The elevator takes a little extra time to level out, but the doors will open if you continue to press the Floor Level button you want. If you don't feel comfortable with this and normally use the elevator to get to the Sanctuary for worship service, we recommend parking in the upper or lower west lots and come in through Door # 5 or 6.

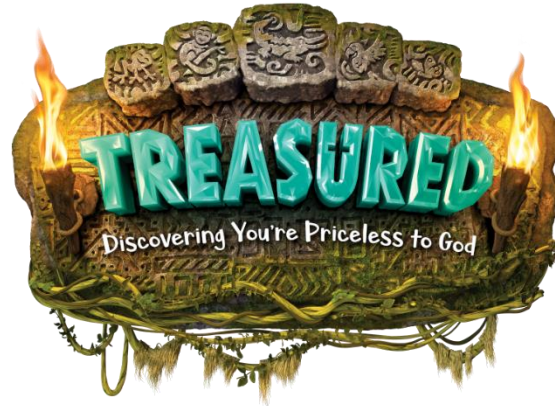
## Tuesday Ladies Bible Study

## FAQs

**What if my children want to be with their friends?** If you have children that you consider to be within your "cohort," you can make them a part of your family group. "Family unit" is not limited to those in your household. Additionally, if there is another family unit you would like in your rotation, please indicate this on your registration. We will do our best to accommodate requests.

**How many children can I have in my group?** An ideal group size is around 6 children. Larger groups make discussions a little more challenging. If you have more than 10 children in your group, we will ask that you have a second adult leader to help guide the group.

**What if my spouse cannot attend?** Only one adult leader is needed per family group. While we would encourage both parents to attend, this is not required.

**What if I have both preschool and elementary students in my family?** We will not separate the preschool and elementary students this year. You can all attend VBS together.

**Are there age limits?** While VBS is designed for children ages 3 through 4th grade, we have found that children of all ages enjoy the fun activities. Just be sure to register all who plan to attend so that we have enough supplies on hand.

**What if we cannot attend every day?** Please indicate the days you plan to attend on your registration form. This helps us plan for supplies. If you cannot attend for a day, we will miss you, but please join us for the remaining days. If a family unit attends, it must have an adult leader. We will not provide crew leaders this year.

**Will there be t-shirts?** We are excited to announce that our t-shirt supplier is making it easier than ever to order VBS shirts. We will have a link soon where t-shirts can be ordered online. Shirts will not be sold at the door this year.
