
St. Peter's Lutheran Church



Dear Friends in Christ,

On the weekend of July 17, 18, & 19, Vicar Nate will be preaching his last "official" sermon as our vicar. To refresh your memory, a "vicar" in our church body is the term used to describe a man who is in his third year of seminary and is assigned to a congregation for a period of one year in order to gain practical parish experience under the direction and supervision of a more seasoned pastor. You might think of it as a year-long internship. Of course, with a vicar, as in the case of Vicar Nate, comes his family. What a joy it has been to have Vicar Nate's wife, Amy, who works in our church office, and daughters Gwyndalyn and Sophia as part of our church family.

I think you will all agree with me that Vicar Nate did a superior job in his vicarage year with us. In fact, given his background as a substance abuse counselor for ten years prior to entering the seminary, he has a wealth of life experience that distinguishes him from your typical seminary student. That being said, I have asked Vicar Nate if he would be willing to continue serving in order to help out with a variety of projects we are undertaking at this time as we gear up for our Fall ministry programming and beyond. Without hesitation he agreed to do what we might call a "summer vicarage" with us. So, even though his one year obligation has officially ended, you will still see Vicar Nate around the church. As a matter of fact, the Board of Directors has allowed me to apply for a grant that would keep Vicar Nate with us on a part-time basis while he finishes his fourth and final year of seminary studies. We will find out whether or not we will receive that grant sometime in late August or early September. So, stay tuned! You might very well see Vicar Nate, at least on a part-time basis, around St. Peter's for another year.

As many of you have commented to me, Pastor McDowell, Vicar Nate, and I make a great pastoral team. Together we feel we can adequately cover all the various aspects of providing pastoral ministry to our congregation, preschool, day school, and the surrounding community. I might add, we also are blessed to have a wonderful office staff, preschool and day school team, and the countless volunteer hours of many lay people such as yourselves. God has richly blessed St. Peter's with a wonderful variety of gifts in the people who serve here. Please join me in thanking Him for all who give so sacrificially and generously of their time, talents, and treasures in order to carry out the important work of sharing the Good News of salvation in Christ Jesus through the variety of ministries that happen here at St. Peter's.

SCRIP- With the announcement of Mr. Tony Hunt, our Director of Advancement, accepting a new position we are moving SCRIP over to the school office. SCRIP order scheduling will remain the same. The Lutheran Scholarship Granting Organization of Indiana (SGO) – Great news, effective July 1, the Indiana legislature greatly improved the income guidelines for both Choice scholarships and SGO scholarships! Many more of our school families will be eligible for these scholarships to assist them in sending their children to our school, which provides a high quality Christian education.

Without getting too technical, it is important to know for these families to receive choice dollars from the state, they need what is called a "track" to qualify. This is why we give SGO scholarships to kindergartners that qualify. Receiving an SGO will allow those families that qualify based on income to then receive choice dollars the following year and every year after. With the increased number of families that will now qualify, we will have a spike in SGO need to provide a track to as many families as possible!

Not only does this program benefit our students, with every gift there is also a direct 50% Indiana State tax credit for the donor. Our members and supporters stepped up last year and contributed to St. Peter's SGO account at a goal-shattering pace of \$46,816. Best year ever, thank you so very much!
