Over the past eighteen months as we have weathered the storm of COVID-19, people in the surrounding community have been required to cope with their issues in isolation. As a result of these circumstances many of our citizen's mental health concerns have come to the forefront including thoughts of suicide. The purpose of this nationwide awareness campaign is to give people an understanding of the reality of this condition and equip them with the basic resources necessary to do something about it.

Throughout the coming month, St. Peter's is committed to help further that awareness. Our staff will be posting statistics, information regarding symptoms, and contact information to help lines and websites that can assist a person in need.

As a pastoral staff, we encourage you to be aware this month and care for one another as Jesus Christ cares for the church.

Tuesday, September 14, The Ladies Bible class will begin the study, *Jesus, the God who knows your name*.


