According to the Anxiety & Depression Association of America.

- Anxiety disorders are the most common mental illness in the U.S.
- 21% of American adults have been diagnosed with an anxiety disorder and 7.1% of children (age 3-17) have been diagnosed as well.
- They are highly treatable yet only 36.9% of those suffering receive treatment.


