### **COVID 19 Ministry Update**

On Wednesday our county advisory level changed to RED status. The advisory level refers to the current guidelines the county must follow. At this time there are no state or county mandates from Allen County Health Commissioner that would impact how we operate our ministry. After evaluating the recommendations from our state and local officials as well as consulting with our COVID-19 Task Force and Board of Elders, we have made the following decisions that will be effective immediately.

- We are offering 1 additional Worship Service on Christmas Eve (3PM). This is the only service with mask & social distancing required by all participants.
- We are suspending the attendance requirements for the Congregational Scholarship until May 31, 2022. Questions regarding this can be directed to Jenny Reith, Parish Administrator.
- We are encouraging all of our members to continue worshiping and engaging in ministry activity to whatever extent they feel comfortable.
- For those uncomfortable with in-person worship and activity, we are encouraging participation in worship via our livestreaming options.
- If you'd like to schedule a private communion please contact the Church Office.

Aside from the additional mask required service on Christmas Eve, all worship activities will continue as they currently are including: open seating, continuous communion, offering collection, and Ritual of Friendship signing. Additionally, we will continue to provide hand sanitizer and masks throughout the facility.

Bible Study continues with Pastor McDowell this weekend at 9:15 am in the Cornerstone Room and via live stream on our YouTube channel.


### **Pastor Steve's Bible Study**

## Quarterly Awareness Event Sunday, January 16th 5-6 pm with a FREE dinner following


Rev. Patrick Riecke is the director of Dignity and Spiritual Care and Chairperson for the Ethics Committee at Parkview Health. He leads a team of chaplains who have responded to more than 10,000 patients' deaths during his tenure. Patrick is the author of How to Talk with Sick, Dying and Grieving People: When there are No Magic Words to Say, and How to Find Meaning in Your Life Before it Ends. His new book, co-authored with his wife, Kristen, is called No Matter How Small: Understanding Miscarriage and Stillbirth.

Patrick speaks about end of life, finding meaning, and grief. He was born and raised in Fort Wayne, IN. He's been married to Kristen since the 1900s and they have four children. When he was five years old, he dreamed of being either a Truck Driver or a Catholic Priest. Neither dream has come true yet.

### **Navigating the Holiday Blues**

Andy Williams might tell us, "It's the Most Wonderful Time of the Year," but for some the holidays can be a challenging time. Loneliness, financial strain, and holiday pressures can worsen mental health struggles, leaving many feeling anxious and/or depressed. At a recent presentation on, "Navigating the Holiday Blues," Christine M. Crawford, MD, MPH, Associate Medical Director, NAMI, gave these tips:

- 1. Stick to normal routines as much as possible. That's good for your children, too, if you have children at home.
- 2. Get enough sleep.
- 3. Take time for yourself, but don't isolate; spend time with supportive, caring people.
- 4. Eat and drink (if you drink) in moderation.
- 5. Move your body; get some exercise. Even 10 minutes a day can make a difference in your mood.
- 6. Set reasonable expectations and goals; don't demand too much of yourself.
- 7. Set a budget for holiday expenses; don't overspend.
