


Blood Drive


Myth: Self-Harm is Attention-Seeking or Manipulative

Self-harm has long been misunderstood as "just" an attentionseeking or manipulative behavior. However, research shows that self-injury is often done in secret, and those who self-harm might not tell anybody about it at all.



- Some experts have found that only about 16% of collegeage students who self-harm told their therapist about it.
- Many who self-harm and have a wound that requires emergency medical care won't go to the ER to keep the self-injury secret.
