
Stress & Burnout

Life is full of stressors: work, family, emergencies, deadlines, illnesses, red lights, lost items, car repairs, home maintenance and more. While some degree of stress keeps us from becoming sluggish and bored, stressors that are piled to high without relief can lead to burnout and other serious health problems.

The body's autonomic nervous system controls your heart rate, breathing, vision changes and more. Its built-in stress response, the "fight-or-flight response," helps the body face stressful situations. When a person has long-term (chronic) stress, continued activation of the stress response causes wear and tear on the body. Physical, emotional and behavioral symptoms develop.

Physical symptoms of stress include:

- Aches and pains.
- Chest pain or a feeling like your heart is racing.
- Exhaustion or trouble sleeping.
- Headaches, dizziness or shaking.
- High blood pressure.
- Muscle tension or jaw clenching.
- Stomach or digestive problems.
- Weak immune system.



Stress can lead to emotional and mental symptoms like:

- Anxiety or irritability.
- Depression.
- Panic attacks.
- Sadness.


