Larry Goeglein Honored for Faithful Service to Burmese Community

At the St. Peter's Lutheran Church Men's Breakfast Bible Study on April 28, the board members of the Lutheran Agency for Missions to Burmese (LAMB) honored Larry Goeglein for his faithful volunteer work among the Burmese people in Fort Wayne. Goeglein was presented with a plaque that read, "In Recognition and Appreciation of Your Faithful Service to the Burmese Community. Ephesians 2:8-10. Soli Deo Gloria."



Goeglein, a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Fort Wayne, began his work among the Burmese people in 2003 by tutoring Burmese students. In 2004 Goeglein became a member of the LAMB board, a year after the agency was formed. As a board member, he helped to shape and expand the ministry to Burmese people throughout the Fort Wayne area and beyond. He has served on the board as president, treasurer, and financial secretary. A few of LAMB's accomplishments during his time on the board included starting a refugee housing ministry, an ESL program in partnership with Bethlehem Lutheran Church, and the production of a movie to improve marriages called "A Greater Love."

Goeglein's teaching and business background has been an invaluable asset to LAMB and Burmese ministry in the greater Fort Wayne area. He not only led the LAMB board and served on it faithfully, but he also rolled up his sleeves and pitched in on hands-on projects. His advice and encouragement have blessed the LAMB board, volunteers, staff, and the Burmese community.


