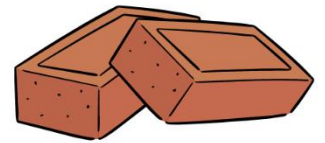
Proceeds from our campaign will fund the walkway and build our endowment fund which will provide financial support to future students for generations to come.
