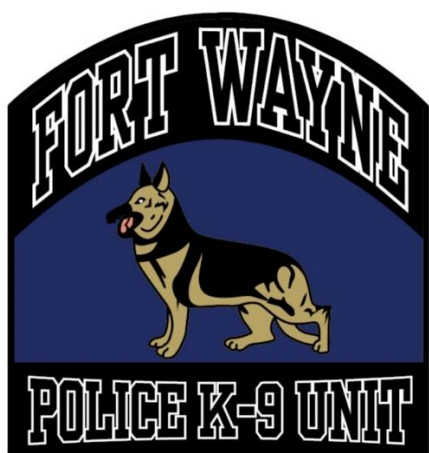
Ladies Bible Study
