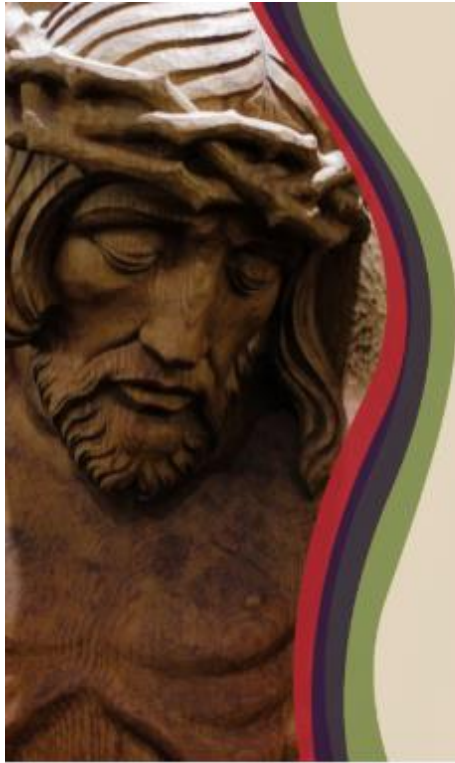

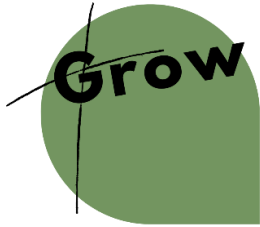

Pastor Steve's Thursday Noon Bible Study

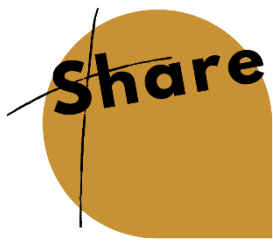
The weekly noon Bible Study focused on the book of Revelation will take a break for the holidays. Regular meetings will resume on January 19th.

Lost & Found

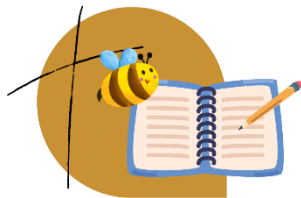

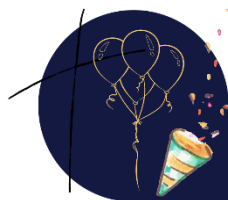

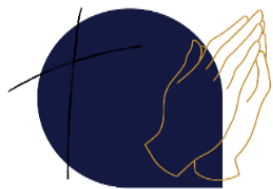
