

- Michelle's grief support starts at 6 pm in the Ministry Conference Room.



1. Save a Life, Learn CPR

Saturday, February 18: 9am-1pm

When someone's heartbeat and breathing stops, every minute thereafter without giving CPR and using an AED, the survival rate drops 7-10%. One way we can help is to learn the basics of CPR and the use of an AED. Brian West, one of our Church Elders and a Red Cross Instructor, will be leading



a class at the Jackson Lehman YMCA on Saturday, February 18 from 9 am to 1 pm. The registration fee is FREE for the first 10 members that sign up and \$30 for each member after that.
