Dear St. Peter's Parents and Students,

July 25, 2018

Greetings in the Lord!

As you know, St. Peter's Lutheran Church places a very high value on Christ-centered, excellent education. The congregation implements this core value in two ways: (1) providing a day school for grades K to 8th grade and (2) providing a partial tuition scholarship for member families with students attending the Day School.

This congregationally paid scholarship to attend the day school contributes up to \$3,250.00 per academic school year. This scholarship, however, is not automatic and *must be requested* by the family annually. It also requires commitment by both the student and parents. Failure to meet the commitment may lead to the scholarship being denied.

That commitment is as follows:

1. Each student in a family receiving the scholarship and at least one parent must attend a minimum of **28 weekly worship services per year (June 1-May 31)** every year. The attendance count is determined by entries in the "Ritual of Friendship" pads during worship. Midweek services (Advent and Lent) & special worship services count towards the 28 (Good Friday attendance is not taken). If the student or parent(s) fail to meet this worship attendance requirement, then the scholarship will be denied the next academic year at the Day School and/or CLHS. The annual period is from **June 1st through May 31st** each year.
2. Be a positive representative of St. Peter's Lutheran Church.

If you wish to receive the congregational scholarship for the 2018-19 academic year, please complete the backside of this letter and bring it to Wildcat Night, August 8, 2018. (An additional copy of this letter is enclosed for your reference). Should you have concerns about your ability to fulfill this commitment and/or St. Peter's attendance records, or need further clarification of these requirements, please direct all inquiries to the Parish Administrator first, who works as the liaison for the Board of Elders Day School Attendance Subcommittee.
